1 John 2:1

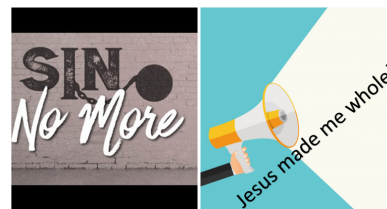
