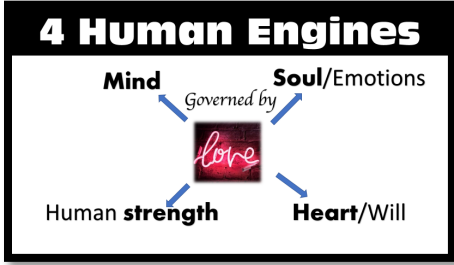

“Redemption is the means; worship is the _____. In one sense, worship is the whole point of everything. It is the purpose of history, the goal of the whole Christian story. Worship is not one segment of the Christian life among others. Worship is the _____ Christian life, seen as a priestly offering to God. And when we meet together as a church, our time of worship is not merely a preliminary to something else; rather, it is the whole point of our _____ as the body of Christ.”

“Worship is the response of the whole being – heart, soul, mind, strength – to beholding God’s _____ . It is enabled by the Holy Spirit. **(There is no worship apart from spiritual regeneration.)** It is fixated on gospel truth. **(We behold God’s glory in the face of Jesus Christ.)** It is directed by God’s self-revealing Word. **(We don’t intuitively figure out what pleases God.)** It involves personal and corporate expressions. **(We worship in all of life as well as in church gatherings.)** Human beings are hard-wired for worship.
